CONDITIONS OF ENTRY, PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Receptacles for display of cut flowers to be provided by the exhibitor

1. Entries limited to 2 per person, per class.
2. Any receptacle used by the exhibitor must be collected personally to avoid errors. No responsibility will be accepted by the steward or the Association for the loss damage or destruction of any receptacles.
3. Entry forms only for flower section to be correctly filled out and personally given to the steward with exhibit.
4. Children classes when filling out entry form, please write child's name and age.
5. D means distinct or different.
6. NND, means need not be different.
7. Novice; people who have never entered the show before.



TIPS FOR EXHIBITORS.

For your flowers to be shown better choose a container that allows your flowers to be 4 to 6" above the neck of the container, no JAM JARS are to be entered. Use a narrow neck container if you only have a few flowers. If your flowers will not stand up properly and inclined to fall over, use some cotton wool for the neck of the vase.
