COMPETITION RULES:

NOTE: PIC (Property Identification Code) Numbers

As from 1/9/2012, people with horses on their property need to apply for a Property Identification Code – this is a biosecurity measure. PICs are assigned to individual properties and allocated by the LLS who maintain the register. You may already have a PIC if you pay your rates to LLS. Every Exhibitor bringing horses to the show will be required to list each horse being shown, together with their PIC for the property from which it has come on the Waiver Form before competing. ASC Horse Committee.

• All classes will stop at 12 noon for Opening of the Show

- Competitors should be standing ringside awaiting their classes.
- Events will only be delayed at the discretion of the appropriate judge.
- Lunch break will be taken at the judge's discretion.
- Any horse or rider deemed dangerous will be asked to leave the ring.
- Drugging of horses will not be tolerated.
- Drug testing may be carried out at this Show.
- Any competitor found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee
- Led Stallions and colts must be exhibited with a bit in their mouths and handled by a responsible person 17 years and over.
- Unruly animals may be asked to leave the ring.
- A horse at this show is either a Show Hack or a Show Hunter - one is not eligible for the other.
- In all breed classes, horses must be registered with the appropriate breed societies and papers MUST be provided if requested, including current proof of membership
- **There must be two entries before a Champion ribbon will be awarded or at the judge's discretion**
- Every rider is encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. Riders under 18 years must wear such a helmet.

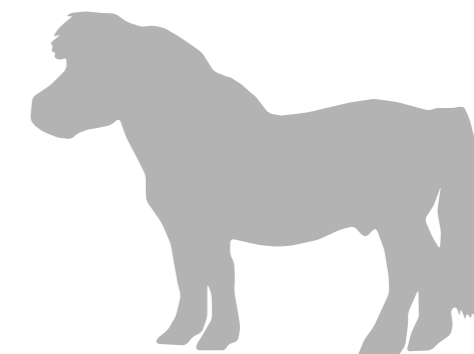

RING 4 - TRIAL RIDE CHALLENGE

STEWARD: *Rachel Meek*

10.00AM START - 1.30PM FINISH

- The objective of this challenge is to demonstrate a rider's and horse's capacity to calmly, precisely, stylishly and regularly deal with any obstacles designed to simulate difficulties which could be encountered by a trail horse.
- All obstacles are numbered in order of completion. The number is placed on the right-hand side of the entrance to the obstacle.
- Competitors may walk the course without horses.
- Refusing an obstacle - the horse stops and takes a backwards step, or circles before entering the obstacle - the rider may have a second attempt, but he third refusal on that obstacle will result in zero points for that obstacle.
- Equine may regard obstacle for a moment, but prolonged hesitation will incur a penalty.
- Event will be timed, time taken will be from start to finish.
- Subtle/refined cues will score higher than obvious cues or harsh use of aids (reins, bit, spurs, whips, sticks, voice).
- A calm, patient, willing equine will score higher than nervousness or rushing.
- There will be a variety of obstacles to negotiate eg. mounting your horse from a mounting block, opening and closing a simple rope gate, walking over carpet, carrying a raincoat and more!
- Rider/horse combinations will be judged on their ability to negotiate each of the tasks and obstacles.
- Horsemanship Prize will be judged across all classes and will focus on the relationship between horse and rider, rather than the emphasis being on obstacles

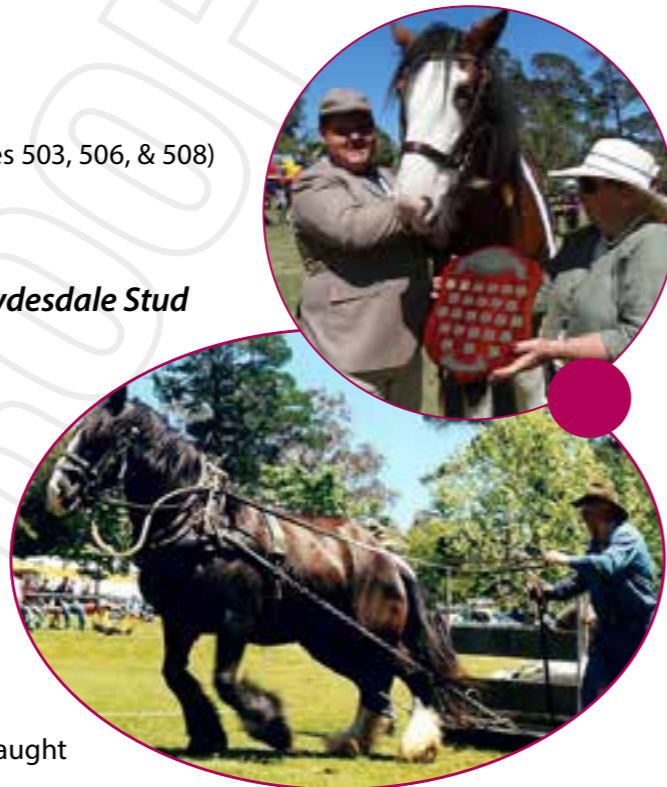
