Receptacles for display of cut flowers to be provided by the exhibitor.

1. Any receptacle used by the exhibitor must be collected personally to avoid errors. No responsibility will be accepted by the stewards or the Association for the loss, damage or destruction of any receptacles.
2. Entry forms only for the flower section to be correctly filled out, and personally given to the steward with exhibit.
3. Children’s classes; when filling out entry forms please write child’s name and age.
4. D; means distinct or different.
5. NND; means need not be or not necessarily
6. Novice ; people who have never entered the show before.

TIPS FOR EXHIBITORS.

For your flowers to be shown better choose a container that allows your flowers to be 4 to 6 ins above the neck of the container no JAM JARS are to be entered. Use a narrow neck container if you only have a few flowers. If your flowers will not stand up properly and are inclined to fall over, use some cotton wool as a plug in the neck of the container.
